

BIOGRAPHY

Adi Holzer was born in 1936 in Stockerau, a little town near Vienna. From 1955-60 he studied at the Academy of fine Arts in Vienna. His instructors were Professors Herbert Boeckl and R.C. Andersen.

In 1955 he met his future wife Kirsten Inger (Kim) in Nice. They were married in Denmark in 1962, and today they reside in a village near Copenhagen and in Carinthia/Austria near the "Top of Austria"- Grossglockner.

Adi has had more than 400 solo exhibitions throughout Europe, USA and Australia:

In 1986 Adi began his work on his Mozart Suite, and in 2005 the famous Glass Studios of Berengo Fine Arts in Murano/Venice began producing glass sculptures from Adi's designs. For Adi this is truly a thrilling experience. Approximately 70 glass sculptures have so far been produced in exclusive, small editions.

His murals, stained glass windows, mosaics, bronze and glass sculptures, etchings, serigraphs and tapestries can be seen in churches and public buildings throughout Europe, USA, Egypt, Australia and Japan.
